

Faculty Positions in Pharmacology and Toxicology

Applications are being accepted for two tenure- or research-track faculty positions in the Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology. The department seeks to strengthen the area of cardiovascular pharmacology and to expand the technological and molecular biological base of the department. Appointment rank and type of appointment are open and dependent upon the qualifications of the applicant with minimum requirements of a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in pharmacology, toxicology or a related field and at least two years of postdoctoral experience. Researchers with expertise in integrative and molecular cardiovascular pharmacology are especially encouraged to apply. However, individuals conducting state-of-the-art research in any area of the pharmacological and/or toxicological sciences will be considered. Successful candidates are expected to establish/maintain independent, extramurally supported research programs, participate in the teaching mission and graduate student training program of the Department and contribute to the service activities of the Department. Preference will be given to individuals qualifying at the level of Assistant Professor, but candidates for appointments above the rank of Assistant Professor must have current extramural funding and evidence of active contribution to graduate training and medical education. Opportunities for interdisciplinary research interactions within the Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology as well as with other departments and centers at the Brody School of Medicine and at East Carolina University are available and encouraged.
